Swimming lessons are 2:00-2:30pm and children will arrive back at school at approximately 3:20pm.

There will be charge of £113 for the following lessons, which will need to be paid via School Money. Parents/carers are not expected to pay this in full amount, there will be 3 instalments to spread out the cost.

First instalment is due Friday 9th September 2022 = £37 Second instalment is due Friday 25th February 2023 = £37 Third instalment is due Friday 27th June 2023 = £37

Please ensure that your child brings a swimming costume (not a bikini) and towel in a bag on a Wednesday morning.

Swimming is an integral part of the curriculum and all pupils are expected to take part unless they are unfit to do so. If your child is unfit to swim on a particular day, please notify the class teacher.

Please remember that jewellery of any description must not be worn during swimming lessons (earrings must be taken out before children arrive to school) and long hair must be tied back and swimming hats must be worn.

Swim socks are allowed to be worn if any children suffer with verruca's. Children can also wear goggles if they wish, but we do ask they know how to put them on and off themselves, adjust the strap and do not mess with them in the lesson.
