At Belle Vue Primary School the curriculum is designed to fulfil the requirements of the national curriculum and, in addition;

Give the children an understanding of themselves as individuals. How they learn, their interpersonal skills, building resilience, confidence, independence creativity and how they can maintain a positive mental health.
