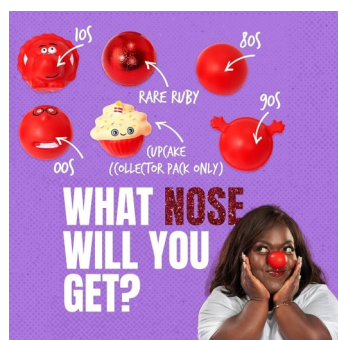
Here's what we've got planned:

## **Belle Vue Netball Team!**

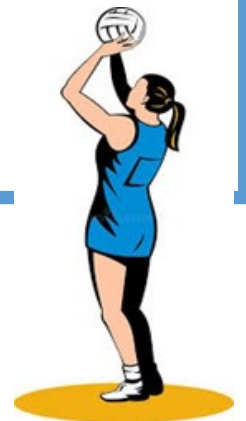
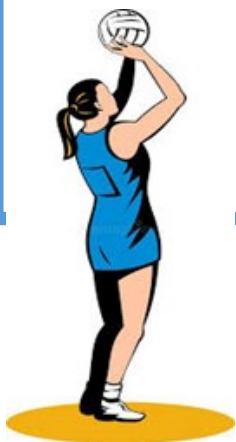
This academic year Belle Vue have restarted their netball team!
