Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we are in the process of organising an exciting educational trip to **Blists Hill Victorian Town** in Telford on **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025**. This visit will provide the children with a fantastic opportunity to experience life in Victorian times and deepen their knowledge and understanding of History and Art.

The total cost of the trip is **£28.11 per child**, which covers the following:

- **Coach travel** to and from Blists Hill: £11.11 per child (£650 total)
- **Entrance to the museum**: £9.50 per child
- **Victorian Schoolroom Experience** (90 minutes): £3.50 per child
- **Intaglio Art Workshop** (90 minutes): £3.50 per child

While we acknowledge that the cost is higher than typical school trips, we truly believe that the educational value of this experience will make it worthwhile. As you can see from the price breakdown, the cost of coach travel has risen considerably over the past year and this is unfortunately out of our control. The Victorian Schoolroom experience will allow the children to experience first-hand what life was like for children in the 19th century. Whereas, the Intaglio Printing workshop will allow children to create their own unique print by etching and applying ink.

By organising the trip so far in advance, we are able to split the cost over **three instalments**:

- The first instalment of **£9.37** is due by **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2024**.
- The second instalment of **£9.37** is due by **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2025**.
- The final instalment of **£9.37** is due by **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025**.

Unfortunately, as with all school trips, if sufficient contributions are not received, this trip cannot take place as school cannot fund the cost of the trip. If you experience any difficulties with the payment schedule or have any concerns, do not hesitate to contact the school office, and we will do our best to assist you.
