

## **Year 4 Swimming**

Dear Parents and Carers,

From **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2025**, Year **4** children will start swimming lessons at The Duncan Edwards Leisure Centre in Dudley. The sessions will run every Wednesday and alternate between the two classes up until Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2025. Please see below lesson dates for both classes.

Swimming lessons are 2:00-2:30pm and children will arrive back at school at approximately 3:20pm.

There will be charge of £44 for the following lessons, which will need to be paid via School Money. Parents/carers are not expected to pay this in full amount, there will be 2 instalments to spread out the cost.

## 4CM

First instalment is due Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025 = £22 Second instalment is due Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2025 = £22

## <u>4T</u>

First instalment is due Friday 21st February 2025 = £22 Second instalment is due Friday 4th April 2025 = £22

Please ensure that your child brings a swimming costume (not a bikini) and towel in a bag on a Wednesday morning.

Swimming is an integral part of the curriculum and all pupils are expected to take part unless they are unfit to do so. If your child is unfit to swim on a particular day, please notify the class teacher.

Please remember that jewellery of any description must not be worn during swimming lessons (earrings must be taken out before children arrive to school) and long hair must be tied back and swimming hats must be worn.

Swim socks are allowed to be worn if any children suffer with verruca's. Children can also wear goggles if they wish, but we do ask they know how to put them on and off themselves, adjust the strap and do not mess with them in the lesson.
