We are in our second term and have new sports underway. The children in all year groups are enjoying our new sports, games and activities we are doing each lesson.

Year 3 have completed their first 6 weeks at Dodgeball after school club and every single one of them enjoyed themselves and have requested if they can come back again. On **Wednesday 19th January** the second group of year 3's will be starting Dodgeball up until half term.

Football is back up and underway after school and schools are getting in touch for upcoming matches. Letters will go out with all details attached.

I have had the pleasure of visiting the new Duncan Edwards Leisure Centre which looks absolutely amazing. I feel the new leisure centre will benefit our children even more with their new facilities. Year 5's first lesson will be on **Wednesday 26th January**. It is important that all children with long hair have their hair tied back and in a swimming hat. Goggles are allowed to be worn as long as the child can adjust the goggles themselves and put them on. Swim socks are also acceptable to wear as long as they have a soft sole.

Please ensure children have outdoor kit in the new year as we will be doing as much PE outside as we can.

- Year 1 PE days Tuesday morning and Friday morning.
- Year 2 PE days Wednesday afternoon and Friday afternoon.
- Year 3 PE days Tuesday afternoon and Monday morning.
- Year 4 PE days Thursday morning and Friday afternoon.
- Year 5 PE days Wednesday afternoon and Friday morning.
- Year 6 PE days Monday morning and Thursday afternoon.

As winter is here, we are making the most of the dry weather. Can we make sure that all children have both their indoor and outdoor PE kit.

Indoor PE kit: white t-shirt, red short and pumps.

Outdoor PE kit: joggers, hoodie or jacket, white t-shirt and trainers.

Children still don't have PE kits in school or do not have a full PE kit. School shoes are not ideal for doing PE in. It is **important that all children have their PE kits in school every term.** If they attend after school clubs and go home in their PE kits please ensure PE kits are returned.

Anxiety Workshop

If your child is struggling with anxiety, then you may be interested in this workshop via Zoom. I have attended a previous session and I found it very informative and useful. It is provided by a company called Educational Psychology for Everyone who provide our school with support. They have provided the details below.
