What an exciting day! Children in Nursery, Reception and Key Stage 1 enjoyed a special Monster Phonics Launch day on **Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> May**. The staff were disguised as their favourite monster and took the children on a special treasure hunt around school searching for the escaped monsters. The children also enjoyed colour coding words, 'Physical Phonics' playing games and reading new Monster Phonics stories.

### Walk to School Week

For 5 days, from Monday 16th May we will be taking part in the national initiative to encourage children to walk to school. Walking to school makes for healthier, happier children. Some of the benefits of walking to school:

- Helps contribute to their daily amount of exercise.
- Allows you to spend more social time with them.
- Can help children build good walking habits from a young age, so they choose to walk more when they can.
- Build children's confidence.
- Teaches them the rules of the road and how to walk safely.
- It can help strengthen relationships with the friends they walk with, which can especially help those starting school.
- Less congestion at the school gate.
- Less pollution around our school entrances.
- Saves money on fuel.

Road safety will be our focus in Monday's assembly. Each child will have a sheet which will be stamped each day they walk. Understandably, some parents need to travel from a distance or need to travel onto work or have mobility issues, perhaps try parking a little further asway.













Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May as a school we took part in a sponsored Wolves penalty shootout to raise money for the school. We had a fantastic day and had a lot of run shooting against Wolfie. Well done to all children who raised money for the shootout. All children who took part in the shootout will receive a goody bag and certificate. Prizes will be presented for those children who raised money in a special assembly. The final deadline to hand in sponsorship money will be **Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May**.

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> May, thirteen of our year 5&6's are playing a football match away against the Brook. The children will be representing the school in our brand new football kit. More matches are coming up and letters will be sent out.

A lot of children have not brought their PE kit after half term or are bringing the wrong uniform for PE, below is listed what the uniform should consist of. We have tried to keep it so it is easy to purchase. It is important we have the correct PE kit to look smart and consistent across the school.

4W started their first after school club on Wednesday. We all had a great time playing dodgeball and look forward to our next lesson. There will be <u>no</u> after school club on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> May but this session will be added on, so the children don't miss out. Letters will go out with all details on.

Indoor and outdoor kit needs to be in school every week as we will be doing as much PE outside as we can. Children are also able to wear coats, gloves, hats/caps, snoods or scarfs if this wish too. It is essential that all children have trainers to wear outdoors as school shoes are not permitted and pumps are not ideal.

Indoor PE kit: white t-shirt, red short and pumps.

Outdoor PE kit: Black/Navy or Grey joggers, hoodie or jacket, white t-shirt and trainers.

If they attend after school clubs and go home in their PE kits please ensure PE kits are returned.

### HAF Registration

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Have you heard of holiday activities within Dudley?

Dudley HAF is a programme that started as a pilot scheme last year for children and families who receive free school meals or income eligible families.

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The programme provides a wide range of inclusive, accessible, fun and educational activities through Christmas, Easter and summer school holidays.

The scheme will now continue to run going forward after reaching out to 4000 children and families in Dudley over the last year alone.

Many local organisations, businesses and voluntary groups take part working closely with Dudley CVS and Dudley Council in planning events and activities borough wide through the holidays.

Registration for new families to register opens on 3rd May 2022 and closes 26th May 2022. If you are already registered, you do not need to do anything other than tell your friends and other parents who are eligible but aren't registered to get in touch!


