Sunny Weather

POLITE REMINDER School Lunches: Please can we remind you to book your child/childrens lunches in advance. Lunches can't be ordered on the day. Our catering providers have advised us that due to the implantation of Natasha's Law all meals have to be booked in advance. The kitchen will not cater for children whose meal has not been booked. Our online system allows you to book until midnight the night before. Please be aware that if your child does not have a packed lunch or a meal booked, the office staff will call parents/carers and ask them to bring a packed lunch to school. Even If you are on Free School Meals please ensure that you click the basket and click pay. This will not take payment but will ensure that your child's lunch is booked.



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Amazing Minority Instrument Project—9 free instrumental lessons!

Dear Parent/Carer,

Starting after Easter 2025 we have an amazing opportunity for any KS2 pupil to learn what are known as minority instruments. These are instruments usually found in an orchestra that are dwindling in number—cello, double base, oboe, bassoon, euphonium and tuba.

Over the next 9 weeks we will run beginner group lessons on a Monday or Tuesday at our music base at Cable Plaza on the Waterfront near Merry Hill. Each lesson will last for 25 minutes. The children will all be beginner students and learn how to play a musical instrument in a fun, relaxed group environment. All the instruments will be provided, and they will be able to bring their instrument home every week to allow them to practice and try new things!


